

Enlisted to Medical School Preparatory Program

MILPER Message 15-266

The EMDP2 is a post-baccalaureate 2 year resident trailing program for select, qualified regular Army enlisted Soldiers to complete additional coursework necessary to prepare for the Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) and to meet the course prerequisites to apply to medical school. The Army has partnered with the Uniformed Service University of Health Sciences, which is located in Bethesda, Maryland, to provide this opportunity for select, qualified Soldiers to remain on active duty while completing the necessary coursework to apply for admission to the USUHS School of Medicine and other civilian medical schools via the Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP)

The application deadline is 15 January 2016.
