

The AMEDD Museum encourages all Corps and specialties to seek out and pass along photos, equipment, documents, artifacts or objects (related to one's service) to the AMEDD Museum and the Army Medical Department Center for History and Heritage (ACHH) archive.

Please help the AMEDD story to be told "even better."

The goal of the AMEDD museum is to source recent examples of AMEDD Corps and Specialty photos and contemporarily utilized artifacts, as well as historical ones, in order to tell the current/more recent story of Army Medicine, and also so the recent evolutions of the Corps and their organizational structures can be demonstrated. The museum staff is currently in planning stages of making updates to the contemporary period exhibits and are, therefore, seeking input from the Corps and Specialties as to what types of artifact items best represent these relatively current activities. This is very important to the museum because they are not experts on what every Corps does. Information is vital to provide the best possible museum visitor experience. To that end, the museum staff is seeking help in learning what items best represents their Corps roles by acquiring photos and equipment to support and tell that story.

Artifacts & Objects: 3D objects are accepted through the museum staff and require a small amount of paperwork identifying the donor and any pertinent information about the provenance and history of the items. Once the museum is contacted and a few details are provided, a determination is made whether the museum can accept the material. It is a very simple process that keeps the collection of the museum from getting too cluttered with duplicative material.

The highest resolution possible is preferred for digital photos. Photos can be submitted via email (usarmy.jbsa.medcom-ameddcs.list.amedd--regiment@mail.mil) CD or an online folder for large data files can be provided.

Documents and printed images/photos also require documentation and captions to identify where items originated.
